קִדּוּשׁ Kiddush (the blessing over wine) | kadeish |

וּרְחַצְתָּ Ritual hand-washing in preparation for the seder | urchatz |

כַּרְפָּס Dipping a green vegetable in salt water | karpas |

יַחַצ Breaking the middle matzah | yachatz |

מַגִּיד Telling the story of Passover | magid |

רַחֲצָה Ritual hand-washing in preparation for the meal | rachtza |

מוֹצֵי מַצָּה The blessing over the meal and matzah | motzi matzah |

מָרוֹר Dipping the bitter herb in sweet charoset | maror |

קוֹרֵיחַ Eating a sandwich of matzah and bitter herb | koreich |

עוֹרֵיחַ Eating the meal! | shulchan oreich |

צַפּוֹן Finding and eating the Afikomen | tzafoon |

בָּרֵיחַ Saying grace after the meal and inviting Elijah the Prophet | bareich |

הַלֵּל Singing songs that praise God | hallel |

נִרְטָזַח Ending the seder and thinking about the future | nirtzah |
