- Z'roa** - a 'roasted bone' that represents the Passover sacrifice offered while the Temple stood in Jerusalem
- Beitza** - a roasted egg, representing both the Passover offering and the cycle of life and death
- Maror** - A bitter herb, which reminds us of the bitterness of enslavement
- Charoset** - A mixture of fruit, nuts, wine and spices, which represents the mortar our ancestors used to build the pyramids
- Karpas** - A green vegetable, which symbolizes hope and renewal
- Chazeret** - A second bitter vegetable, again reminding us of the harshness of slavery
- and an **Orange** - acknowledging the role of women in Jewish myths, community and society overall
