Baruch Atah Adonai, Eloheynu Melech Ha'Olam, sheh-hech-chi-ahnoo, vih-kee-yih-mah-noo, vih-hig-ee-ahnoo, lahz-mahn, hazeh.

Blessed are You, Lord our God, Ruler of the universe, Who has kept us alive and brought us to this happy moment in our lives.

(Pour first cup of wine)

Baruch Atah Adonai, Eloheynu Melech Ha'Olam Borey P'ree Hagafen.
