בְּכָל־דּוֹר וָדוֹר חַיָּב אָדָם לִרְאוֹת אֶת־עַצְמוֹ, כְּאִלוּ הוּא יֵצֵא מִמִּצְרַיִם

*B'chol dor vador chayav adam lirot et-atzmo, k'ilu hu yatzav mimitzrayim.*

In every generation, everyone is obligated to see themselves as though they personally left Egypt.
