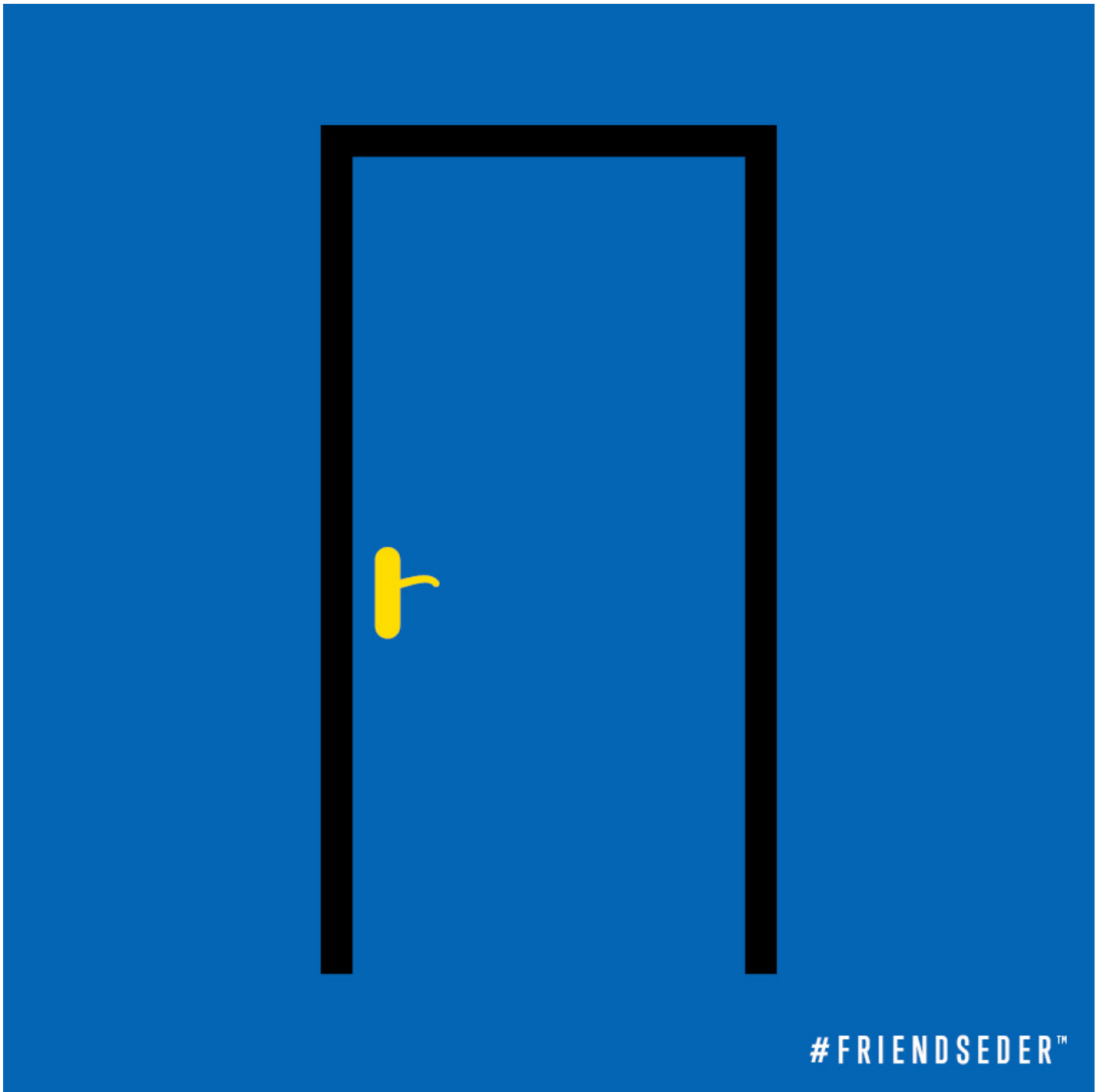


Gratitude
