The afikoman is the last thing eaten at the seder. It is the matzah we've broken apart, hidden, and will now bring back together to eat as a whole.

The afikomen represents reuniting the 12 tribes of Israel, reuniting the different parts of Judaism today. It's a reminder to resist treating Judaism as a homogenous whole: our community is comprised of immigrant Jews, queer Jews, Jews of color, secular Jews, and every other Jewish identity.
