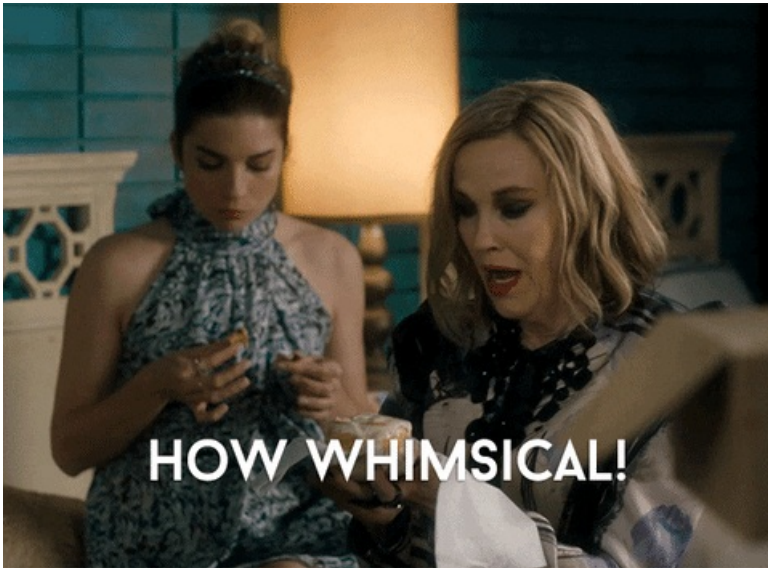


## Schitt's Creek Yachatz

Yachatz is when we break the matzah and put half -- called the Afikoman -- away for later, like a special flat treat.
