GI-Net also provides you with updated talking points so that you can urge your elected officials to take meaningful action to help end the genocide in Darfur. Please have one person at your table make a call, using the speaker feature so that others can participate in the experience.

Upon completion of the call, we fill our cups, recite a blessing, and drink the second cup.
